Scholarship Eligibility

The Dorset College student scholarship committee awards up to 10 scholarships to qualified Dorset students each semester (30 scholarships per year). There are 3 semesters in each school year. In order to qualify for a Dorset College Scholarship, scholarship candidates must:

- 1) Be currently registered as a Dorset College student;
- 2) Demonstrate a high level of academic achievement;
- 3) Maintain a high attendance record;
- 4) Demonstrate that they have contributed to Dorset College in a positive way (examples: acted as a Student Representative, Volunteered to help teachers and/ or other students)
- 5) Write a 500-words essay (please see the inside of this form for details)
- 6) Submit two written teacher recommendations. (Please see the back of this form for details.)

Scholarship Awards

The scholarship competition is open to all Dorset students. Scholarships will be given out in amounts of \$300 and \$500. The Dorset College Scholarship Committee will take all application requirements and the student's current English level into account. Scholarships will be awarded to the best overall candidates.

Winners will be announced at the opening ceremony of the following semester.

Students are instructed to submit the completed application form one week prior to the end of the academic semester. Qualified students will be notified within three weeks by a written response from the Dorset College Student in Course Scholarship Committee as to the scholarship amount awarded.

2. Essay Requirements

Students must write a 500-word essay. Please be as honest, creative and detailed as possible in your essay. Your essay must answer the following questions:

- 1) Why am I applying for a Dorset College Student Scholarship?
- 2) What have I done to deserve a Dorset College Student Scholarship?
(Ex. Demonstrated a high level of academic achievement, excellent attendance)
- 3) How have I contributed to Dorset College to create a more positive school environment?
(Ex. Acted as a Student Representative, volunteered to help my teachers, helped other students.



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4. Student Scholarship Teacher Recommendations

Each scholarship candidate must ask for two written recommendations from two different teachers. It is the teacher's decision as to whether or not they wish to write a recommendation for a student. Recommendations should be submitted attached to this form. A teacher's comments may be based upon academic performance, attendance, class participation or any other relevant positive recommendation. Please attach written recommendations.
